CORAVIN

Coravin is a tool that allows us to pour small amounts of wine without ever opening the bottle. It replaces poured wine with neutral Argon gas and then the cork expands resealing the bottle as if it had never been opened. This allows us to showcase some of our more premium wines by the glass.

Chablis, Pattes Loup vent d'Ange, Thomas Pico, Bourgogne, 2018. £15 (125ml)
Rich in apricot and ripe grapefruit with a hint of nuttiness on the nose, be ready for something different to your standard Chablis.

Giodo Sangiovese, Carlo Ferrini, Toscana I.G.T, Italy, 2013. £19 (125ml)

This wine dazzles with aromas of dark cherries and wild berries, sweet spices and eucalyptus, followed by silky tannins and beautiful acidity from one of Tuscany's top winemakers.

CHAMPAGNE DEVAUX COLLECTION

Champagne Devaux was originally founded in 1846, by the brothers Jules and Auguste Devaux. Today, the estate is owned by the Union Aubeoise in the Côte des Bar, the heartland of Pinot Noir in Champagne. Physically closer to Chablis than Reims or Épernay, vines in the Côte des Bar are grown on Burgundian soils of Kimmeridgian marl and Portlandian limestone. Devaux ages most of their reserve wines in oak barrels of different sizes, toasts and ages, which are all sourced locally to minimise environmental impact. The intelligent use of oak in Devaux's wines led Eric Label, Chef de Cave of Krug, to refer to Devaux as the 'the Krug of the Côte des Bars'.
